Town and Country Planning Acts 1962-1968 London Government Act 1963 Torrians Primary School, Torriano Avenue

I would refer to your letter of 31st October, 1968 submitting details of the above proposed development as shown on the drawings referred to (Reg. No. 7922); these have now been considered by the Council, and I am to inform you as follows:-

- 1. Pursuant to Condition 1 of the planning permission issued by letter dated 19th September 1969, for the redevelopment of the sites of Nos. 9-39 Torriano Avenue and buildings at rear, 15-17 Busby Place and buildings at rear by the erection of buildings for use as an extension to Torriano Primary School, the Council hereby:-
 - (a) APPROVES the details of the school building and school-keeper's house as shown on drawings Reg. No. 7922 (applicant's Nos. S/564/004,104, 107, 108, SHI.H, SH2,H, SH12.2).
 - (b) DISAPPROVES the details of the chain link fences and gates as shown on drawing Reg. No. 7922 (applicant's No. S/564/014) for the reason that such enclosure would be out of keeping with the character of the area, and would emphasise both the different scale and the unfortunate retention of No. 27 Torriano Avenue.
- 2. Further, the Council is disappointed that the design of the school is not better related to the locality in both siting and design. The Council would be prepared

to accept boundary enclosures of brick walls (of salvaged enterial from the existing buildings) or other personent material. It would also welcome a tree planting scheme for the total site to allow for the later removal of existing trees.
