Town & Country Planning Acts 196./68 London Government Act 1963 Torrismo Frimery School, Torrismo Avenue

Referring to your letter dated 8th February 1971 submitting revised proposals regarding the setting out of the schoolkseper's house, garage, car parking arrangements and landscaping; these have now been considered by the Council, and I am to inform you as follows:-

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1. That pursuant to Condition (1) of the planning permission issued by letter dated 19th September 1969, for the erection of buildings for use as an extension to Torrismo Primary School the Council hereby:-

(a) APPROVES the revised details as shown on Drawing Regd. No. 10504 (your 5/364/003/B) in respect of the schoolkoeper's house and car parking provision.

(b) APPRIVES the implementary proposals as shown on Drawing Regd. No. 10504 (your $\frac{554}{004/E}$) with the exception of the use of chain link feacing.

Mease note that the Council is anxious to see proposals for the boundary fence to be other than chain link fencing, and also that consideration should be given to the car parking arrangements in designing the second building stage, so that better segregated facilities can be provided in the permanent lay-out.
