Development: The demolition and rebuilding of Nos. 20-22 Theobald's Road, Holborn, for office purposes with one flat.

Reasons for refusal: These are buildings of special architectural and historic interest listed under Section 30 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, and as such are buildings which the Council considers should be preserved; and in any case it is not considered that the provision of one flat is an adequate replacement for the residential accommodation now existing on the site and it is the Council's policy to require an equivalent amount of residential accommodation to be provided on redevelopment.
