
I refer to your memorandum dated 2 July 1984 submitting details of enclosure fencing pursuant to condition 1 of the deemed planning permission granted on 18 June 1984 (registered number 8400481) for the erection of a 3-metre high chain-link fence on top of the perimeter wall of the all-weather games space in Swiss Cottage Gardens.

I have to inform you that the details submitted in your memorandum dated 2 July 1984 and shown on drawings A4/2269/105B and 106B are hereby approved, subject to the following condition:

- 1 The limited period for the retention of the fencing shall be until 1 August 1989, at which time renewal of permission will be required.

The reason for the condition is as follows:

- 1 To ensure that the fencing is kept in good order.
