## Town and Country Planning Acts, 1947 to 1959 50/51 Russell Source, Holborn

With reference to your application of 16 March 1962, to inform you that, pursuant to Condition (1) of the planning a mission issued by letter dated 19 May 1960 for the redevelopment the site Nos. 50-51 Russell Square, Holborn, by the erection of building of basement, ground, and five-storeys over for use as with a residential flat on the top floor, the details shown in Registered Number 27518 (your drawings Nos. B77/B 3-4) have been approved by the Council.

I have further to inform you that -

- (1) The proposed canopy over the main entrance to 250-51 Russell Square will require considerating and Section of the London Building Acts (Amendment) Act, 1939, and the District Surveyor should be consulted with regard to the Building Acts and By-laws, in particular under By-law 11. regard to the lighting and ventilation to the internal kine and stairs, and under By-law 5.26 with regard to openings external walls.
- (2) It is necessary to obtain consent under Section the London Building Acts (Amendment) Act, 1939 with regarments of escape.
- (3) Both frontages of the proposed building should with Section 22 of the London Building Acts, 1930, and salvised to consult the District Surveyor in this respect.
