Town and Country Planning (General Development) Order, 1950

With reference to your letter of 19th August, 1954, I am directed to inform you, with regard to the permission granted under the Town and Country Planning (General Development) Order, 1950, for the erection of a new building comprising basement storage, shops facing Red Lion Street on the ground floor and office accommodation of five upper floors at 23-27, Sandland Street, 1-9, Gray's Inn Passage and 16-20, Red Lion Street, Holborn, as shown on the plans No. 4458 (your Nos. 102-104/R), the Council, in pursuance of its powers under the above-named Order, hereby modifies its permission so as to read:-
