Reasons for refusal: The proposed uses are inappropriate and undesirable and likely to be detrimental to the amenities of the flats above. Your attention is invited to the Council's letter to Messrs. H. and G.E. Jacobs, dated 29th March, 1939, in which they were informed that the letting off of garage space to private car owners, provided that priority was given to the tenants of the flats, would not contravene the conditions of the consent dated 14th August, 1937, for the erection of this building.
