Development : The erection of an additional storey over existing single-storey building at the premises of T.L. Jacey, Ltd., known as No. 12, Oval Road, and No. 57, Jomestown Road, St. Pancras.

Reasons for refusal (1) The proposal constitutes an excessive extension of an industrial use which does not accord with the Council's Development Plan in which this area is allocated for residential purposes.

(2) The proposal would infringe the Council's standards as regards the daylighting of buildings where it abuts on the gardens of houses in Gloucester Crescent.

(3) The proposal constitutes an undesirable extension of industry within the area and does not accord with the Council's policy of restricting the expansion of industry within the County.
