Statement of Applicant's Rights Arising from Granting of Permission Subject to Conditions

- 1. If the applicant is aggrieved by the decision of the local planning authority to grant consent subject to conditions, he may, by notice served within six months of receipt of this notice, appeal to the Secretary of State, Department of the Environment, Whitehall, London, SW1, in accordance with paragraph 8 of Schedule 11 to the Town and Country Planning Act 1971. The Secretary of State has power to allow a longer period for the giving of a notice of appeal and he will exercise his power in cases where he is satisfied that the applicant has deferred the giving of notice because negotiations with the local planning authority in regard to the pro
 - posed works are in progress.
- 2. If listed building consent is granted subject to conditions whether by the local planning authority or by the Secretary of State, and the owner of the land claims that the land has become incapable of reasonably beneficial use in its existing state and cannot be rendered capable of reasonably beneficial use by the carrying out of any works which have been or would be permitted, he may serve on the Council of the County Borough, County District or London Borough in which the land is situated (or, where appropriate, on the Council of the City of London) a listed building purchase notice requiring that Council to purchase his interest in the land in accordance with the provisions of Section 190 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
- 3. In certain circumstances, a claim may be made against the local planning authority for compensation, where permission is granted subject to conditions by the Secretary of State on appeal or on a reference of the application to him. The circumstances in which such compensation is payable are set out in Section 172 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971
