199-206 High Holborn and Part of Sites 2-8 Newton Street, WC1

I refer to your letter dated 5th August 1976 regarding submission of details pursuant to Condition (1) of the outline planning permission dated 12th July 1976 for the retention of the existing facade at Nos. 199/201 High Holborn and the redevelopment of the site of the remainder of the building together with the sites of Nos. 201 (a) - 206 (odd) High Holborn and Nos. 2-8 Newton Street (even) for shops, offices, housing and ancillary storage, servicing and car parking areas and plant rooms.

I have to inform you that the details shown on drawings Registered No. 23184(R) your numbers 1115/2806 - 2806B, 2807, 2808A, 2809 - 2810, 2811A, 2812 (with the exception of details of the canopy on the High Holborn elevation) and the material submitted (brown facing brick, art stone fascia, bronze medallion window frames and bronze anti-sun glass) are hereby approved in part compliance therewith.

Informative:

In order to comply fully with the outline planning permission your attention is drawn to the requirements of Conditions Nos. 15 and 16 of the permission concerning refuse disposal and landscaping details.

You are also requested to give further consideration to the detailing of the proposed canopy on the High Holborn elevation and submit details to the Council for approval.
