I refer to your letter dated 15th June 1977 submitting revised details pursuant to conditions (1) + (16) of the outline planning permission dated 12th July 1976 for the retention of the existing facade of Nos.199-201 High Holborn and the redevelopment of the site of the remainder of the building together with the sites of 201a-206 (cons) High Holborn and Nos.2-8 (even) Newton Street for shops, offices, housing and ancillary storage, servicing and car parking areas and plant rooms.

I have to inform you that the Council hereby approves the revised details shown on drawings Registered No.24765, yours Nos.401-412, (with the exception of:-

- (i) the details of the ground floor frontages and canopy to High Holborn and Newton Street
- (ii) the layout of the rear service area
- (iii) the details of the landscaping of all unbuilt and roof areas
- (iv) the materials submitted)
