THE HOLBORN TOWN HALL AND LIBRARY, NO 197 HIGH HOLBORN, LONDON WC1

I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to say that he has considered your Council's application submitted with your letter of 3 January 1985, for listed building consent for the alteration of the Holborn Town Hall and Library (the Old Town Hall), No 197 High Holborn, London WCl, which is on the statutory list of buildings of special architectural or historic interest in the London Borough of Camden. The application was made in accordance with the provisions of regulation 11 of the above Regulations.

It is noted that no representations were received following public advertisement of the proposals and that the Greater London Council raise no objection to this scheme for the enlargement of office accommodation. No reason is seen to withhold the consent sought and, accordingly, the Secretary of State hereby grants listed building consent for the alteration of the Holborn Town Hall and Library, No 197 High Holborn, London WCl, in accordance with your Council's application dated 23 May 1984, and the submitted drawings Nos 666 (marked "Alteration to Room 19A: existing layout showing alterations"), 666 (marked "Alterations to Room 19A: proposed scheme showing completion"), and an un-numbered drawing entitled "Holborn Town Hall: 1st Floor. This letter does not convey any approval or consent required by any enactment, byelaw, order or regulation other than Sections 55 and 56 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

The works to which this consent relates shall be begun not later than 31 March
