1. In order to comply with the provisions of Section 41 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

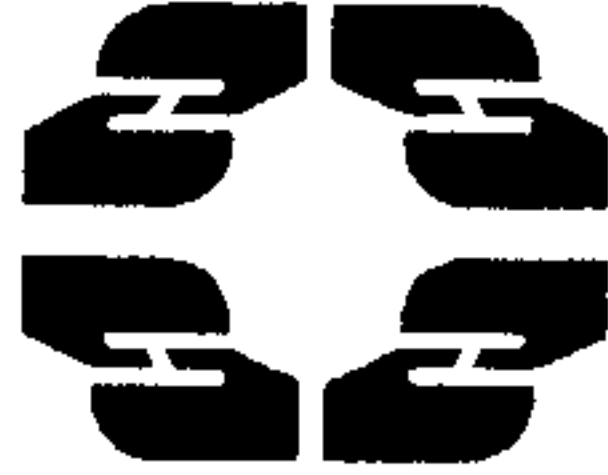
Additional Condition(s):
