- 01 The two rooms shall be used only for the purpose of a museum and reading room associated with the former residence of Professor S.Freud. In the event of the use being determined the premises shall return to residential use.

Reason(s) for Additional Condition(s):

- 01 In granting this planning permission the Council has had regard to the special circumstances of the case. If the use should cease they would wish residential use to be resumed.
