Reasons for Refusal

- 1 The removal of additional condition 01 of the planning permission dated 7th December 1993 (Reg.no.PL\9301042) is considered to be unacceptable. More particularly the loss of the proposed terrace would reduce the amenities of the residential unit proposed at first floor level.
- 2 The proposed development is considered to be unacceptable in that it is contrary to Development Standard DS.5 of the Unitary Development Plan as proposed to be amended. More particularly the proposed roof terrace at first floor level on the front elevation would result in a material loss of privacy to the occupants of the residential properties at first floor level either side.


