I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to say that he has considered your Council's application submitted with your letter of 16 February, 1976 for listed building consent for the alteration of No. 19, Jeffrey's Street NW1 which is on the statutory list of buildings of special architectural or historic interest in Camden. The application was made in accordance with the provisions of regulation 10 of the above Regulations.

It is noted that representations received following advertisement of your Council's application from owners of neighbouring properties are broadly in favour of the proposals which involve the conversion of the premises into 2 maisonettes, and that the Georgian Group does not object. It is also noted that the Greater London Council does not oppose the granting of consent provided that any original chimney pieces in the ground and first floor rear rooms shall be retained in situ, that the door between the ground floor front room and the entrance hall be retained and kept fixed shut, and that all work of making good shall be carried out so as to match the original work as closely as possible as regards materials and detailed execution. It is understood from your letter of 23 August 1976 that these requirements are acceptable to your Council and will be complied with.

No reason is seen, therefore, to withhold the consent sought, and, accordingly, the Secretary of State hereby grants listed building consent for the alteration of No. 19, Jeffrey's Street NW1. in accordance with your Council's application dated 5 September 1975 and the submitted drawing 547/3A. This letter does not convey any approval or consent required by any enactment, byelaw, order or regulation other than Sections 55 and 56 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971.

A copy of this letter is being sent to the Greater London Council.
