Refusal of Permission to Develop

The Council, in pursuance of its powers under the above-mentioned Act and Orders made thereunder, hereby refuses to permit the development referred to in the undermentioned schedule as shown on the plans submitted.

Date of Original Application : 18th December 1985

Address : Flat 19, 109/111, Haverstock Hill, NW3.

Proposal : Erection of a roof extension to enlarge the existing top floor flat, as shown on drawing nos. 874/100/1-15.

Reason(s) for Refusal:

- 01 The proposed development would result in a total density in excess of that indicated as appropriate in the Greater London Development Plan and the District Plan and in the proposed alterations to both plans.
- 02 The proposed scheme exceeds the Council's plot ratio standards for the area and is considered to be overdevelopment of the site.
- 03 The proposed extension is considered to be undesirable as it would obstruct the light to adjoining properties to the detriment of their amenities.
