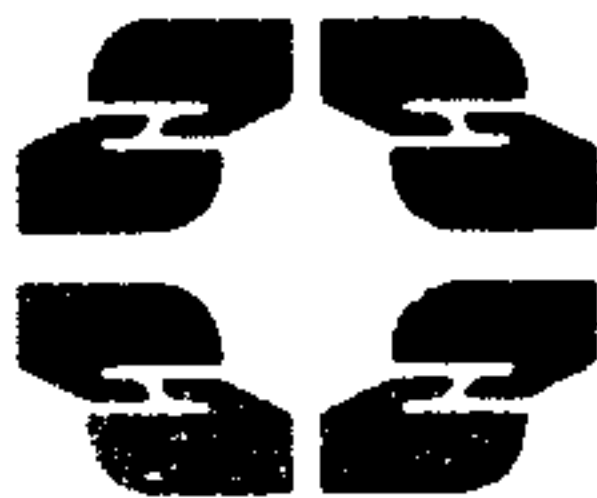

Refusal of Permission to Develop

Proposal : The construction of eight additional off street parking spaces for the residential development as shown on drawing nos 111c and 15A.

Reason(s) for Refusal:

- 01 The proposal would not comply with the Council's policies for the provision of car parking space as set out in the Environmental Code. The proposed space would result in an excessive amount of the site being used for parking purposes.
- 02 The proposed additional parking spaces would result in a loss of a communal open space area which would detract from the residential development and the character of the area generally.
