Reasons for the imposition of conditions:

- (c) External appearance of the building (including materials used and their colour and texture).
 - (d) Means of access to the building.

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- (e) The use of any part of the site not covered by building and the treatment thereof (including planting walls and fences).
- (f) The extent and position of accommodation for car parking in accordance with the Council's planning standards.
- (2) Full particulars and detailed plans and sections of the proposed development to a scale of 8 feet to an inch, or greater, indicating the details reserved for the consideration of the Council in the afore-mentioned condition (1) shall be submitted to and approved by the Council before any work on the site is commenced.

Reason - In order that the Council may be satisfied as to the details of the proposal.

I have to inform you that the trees on the site are the subject of the County of London (Hampstead No. 37) Tree Preservation Order and no tree the subject of a Tree Preservation Order may be lopped, topped or felled without permission under the Order except as provided in the Order or as immediately required for the purpose of carrying out the development for which this permission is given. Advice on this aspect may be obtained from the Hampstead Borough Council.

I have further to inform you that this permission should not be taken in any way as an approval to the two blocks of flats shown on the plan submitted and that pursuant to condition No. 1 an alternative layout to that shown on plans Regd. No. 6932 (Your drawing No. C2369) should be prepared, showing alternative means of access, and that the siting of the blocks as indicated on that plan is not satisfactory, and in this connection it would be desirable to consult Council's Officers in this respect (WATerloo 5000, Ext. 6958).
