Development:

The erection of a building comprising three flats and three maisonettes and the formation of an extension to the existing caretaker's house.

Reason for refusal:

- 1. The proposed scheme exceeds the Council's plot ratio and density standards for the area, and is considered to be over-development of the site.
- 2. It is considered that the total floor space of the building on this site, following the proposed development, would be excessive in relation to the site and the character of the area generally.
- 3. The proposal does not comply with the Council's car parking standards; it would result in an increased demand for car parking in this area which is already heavily parked.
- 4. The Council's daylighting standards are not complied with and access of adequate natural light to adjoining premises would be prevented to the detriment of their amenities.
