Refusal of Permission to Develop

Proposal: Change of use and works of conversion to form 11 self-

88/19/4-10 inclusive.

Reason(s) for Refusal:

O1 The proposed development involves the loss of existing residential accommodation of a type which the Council considers should be retained in this area.

O2 It is considered that the total floorspace of the building, following the proposed extension, would be excessive in relation to the site and the character of the area generally.

03 The proposed extension is considered to be undesirable as it would obstruct the light to adjoining properties to the detriment of their amenities.

O4 The proposed development would result in an over sub-division of the premises and an excessive number of units for the property and area.

O5 The proposed development does not include accommodation suitable for family occupation, contrary to the Council's policies as set out in the Written Statement of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 1987 (the Borough Plan) to encourage the inclusion of such accommodation within schemes for new development or conversion.
