1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to say that he has considered your Council's application submitted with your letter of 19 October 1978 for listed building consent for the alteration of No 88 Pratt Street NW1 which is on the statutory list of buildings of special architectural or historic interest in London Borough of Camden. The application was made in accordance with the provisions of regulation 11 of the above Regulations.

2. It is noted that no representations were received following public advertisement of the proposals and that the Greater London Council raise no objection to this scheme to insert 4 cast iron air bricks in the front facade.

3. No reason is seen to withhold the consent sought, and, accordingly, the Secretary of State hereby grants listed building consent for the alteration of No 88 Pratt Street NW1 in accordance with your Council's application dated 4 July 1978 and the submitted drawings 162/3B & 4A.

4. This letter does not convey any approval or consent required by any enactment, byelaw, order or regulation other than Sections 55 and 56 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971.
