Conditions:

- (1) The limited period for the retention of the mast and building shall be until 31 October 1963 on or before the expiration of which period the structures shall be removed and the use discontinued and determined.
- (2) The structures shall not be erected otherwise than in accordance with detailed drawings including full particulars of the materials proposed, which shall have been approved by the Council before any work on the site is commenced.
