St. Pancras


I refer to the plans submitted with your letter dated 27 November 1963, pursuant to Condition (2) attached to the Council's letter dated 3 October 1963, granting planning permission for the erection of a four storey building to be used for storage purposes on the site on the southern side of Greenwood Place, St. Pancras, and I have to inform you that the Council APPROVES the details as shown on such plans, Registered No. 19623 (your drawing Nos. 61/3/4622 and 61/11/5026-29, as amended by letter dated 17 December 1963).

I would, however, inform you that:-

(a) The St. Pancras Borough Council should be consulted under the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations, 1948-1951, in respect of the proposed sign; and

(b) This decision is given without prejudice to the Council's powers under Section 22 of the London Building Act, 1930.
