I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to say that he has considered your Council's application submitted with your letter of 17 July 1975 for listed building consent for the alteration of 17 Greenland Road, NW1 which is on the statutory list of buildings of special architectural or historic interest. The application was made in accordance with provision of Regulation 10 of the Town and Country Planning (Listed Buildings and Buildings in Conservation Areas) Regulations 1972 as amended by the 1974 Regulations referred to above.

It is noted that no representations were received following public advertisement of the proposals and that the Greater London Council raise no objection to this scheme. Also it is noted that the architects for the scheme, Messrs Pollard, Thomas and Edwards, acting as agents for your Council's Director of Architecture, have confirmed that they will comply with certain detailed conditions suggested by the GLC. No reason is seen, therefore, to withhold the consent sought, and, accordingly, the Secretary of State hereby grants listed building consent for the alterations involved in the conversion of No 17 Greenland Road, NW1, to provide a self-contained maisonette and two self-contained bed sitting flatlets as shown on drawing No A/1033.

This letter does not convey any approval or consent required by any enactment, by-law, order or regulation other than Sections 55 and 56 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

A copy of this letter is being sent to the Greater London Council.
