TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971 REFERRED TO
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL REGULATIONS 1976
1 GREVILLE PLACE NW6

1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to refer to your application dated 26 May 1976 for planning permission for the conversion of the above-mentioned premises into three self-contained residential units. The application was made in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 4(2) of the Town and Country Planning General Regulations 1974 (now Regulation 7(1) of the 1976 Regulations).
2. It is noted that Camden London Borough Council, as local planning authority raised no objection to the proposed works. The Greater London Council, who were consulted, offered no objection to the proposals.
3. The conversion of the premises is acceptable on planning grounds and the demolition of the modern extension is welcomed as this will restore the original appearance of the pleasant Victorian building. The Secretary of State has decided therefore that the scheme as submitted should be approved. Accordingly he hereby grants planning permission for the conversion of No 1 Greville Place, NW6, into three self-contained residential units, in accordance with drawings No 495.04, 05 & 06, submitted in respect of the application, subject to the condition that:-

the development hereby permitted shall be begun not later than 31 March 1982.
4. This letter does not convey any approval or consent required under any enactment, byelaw, order or regulation other than section 23 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
5. A copy of this letter has been sent to the Controller, Department of Planning and Transportation, Greater London Council.
