Development:

The redevolument of Non. 22-30 Goodge Street, Vd by the erection of a five obsery building to comprise basement, storage 2 ground floor shops, first floor showers, second floor office and regidential flots third and fourth floor regidential flats.

Reasons for refusal:

- 1. The proposed office use does not comply with the soming in the Initial Involupment Figs for Vest End purposes which is simed at reducing employment and congestion and at increasing residential accommodation in the some. (Section 5 para. 7 of the Written Statement)
- The prepared building represents an overdevelopment of the site in that it
 is in cases of this Council's plot ratio standard for the area.
- 3. The Council is not prepared to agree to showers use above ground floor level in the absence of any evidence that there is a most or demand for this type of use in the area.

Informative: You are invited to submit revised proposals indicating office use of first floor with the squand floor used entirely for residential purposes.
