REFUSAL OF PERMISSION TO DEVELOP

The Council, in pursuance of its powers under the above-mentioned Acts and Orders made hereunder, hereby refuses to permit the development referred to in the undermentioned Schedule as shown on the plans submitted.

Your attention is drawn to the Statement of Applicant's Rights set out overleaf.

Development: The redevelopment of Nos. 22-30 Gough Street, W1, by the erection of a 6-storey building to comprise, basement storage, 2 ground floor shops, first floor offices and studio, and three floors of residential flats over.

Reasons for refusal:

1. The scheme represents an overdevelopment of the site in that it is in excess of this Council's plot ratio standard for the area.
2. The proposed office use does not comply with the zoning in the Initial Development Plan which is for West End purposes and is contrary to this Council's policy on the restriction of growth of offices in Central London.
3. The Council is not prepared to agree to showroom use above ground floor level in the absence of any evidence that there is a need or demand for this type of use in the area.
4. The proposal is considered to be out of scale with the buildings in the vicinity.
