Date of Original Application: 27/09/1996

Proposal: Erection of fencing and gates at the entrances on Leverton Place and between 318 Kentish Town Road and 7 Falkland Place.

As shown on unnumbered site plan and details of proposed railings.

Reasons for Refusal

The erection of the proposed railings and gate would result in the closure of an existing public footpath, contrary to the provisions of Policy TR2 and TR21 of the emerging Unitary Development Plan, which seek to improve conditions for pedestrians in the Borough.
