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Statement of Applicant's Rights arising from Granting of Listed Building Consent Subject to Conditions

- 1. If the applicant is aggrieved by the decision of the local planning authority to grant consent subject to conditions, he may appeal to the Secretary of State for the Environment in accordance subject to conditions. with paragraph 8 of Schedule it to the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 within six months of receipt of this notice. (Appeals must be made on a form which is obtainable from the Department of the Environment.) The Secretary of State has power to allow a longer period for the giving of a notice of appeal but he will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless there are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of appeal.
- 2. If listed building consent is granted subject to conditions whether by the local planning authority o, by the Secretary of State for the Environment, and the owner of the land claims that the land of my the secretary of State for the Environment, and the owner of the land claims that the land has become incapable of reasonably beneficial use in its existing state and cannot be rendered capable of reasonably beneficial use by the carrying out of any works which have been or would be permitted, he may serve on the Council of the district or London borough in which the land is situated (or, where appropriate, on the Common Council of the City of London) a listed building purchase notice requiring that Council to purchase his interest in the land in accordance with the provisions of Section 190 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
- 3. In certain circumstances, a claim may be made against the local planning authority for compensation, where permission is granted subject to conditions by the Secretary of State on appeal or on a reference of the application to him. The circumstances in which such compensation is payable are set out in Section 171 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
