Statement of Applicant's Rights Arising from the Grant of Permission subject to Conditions

- 1. If the applicant is again yed by the decision of the local pranning authority to grant permission or approval subject to confutions, he may appeal to and on a form obtainable from the Secretary of State for the Environment, Caston House, Tothili Street, London SWIH BBX, in accordance with Section 36 of the Town and Country Piece ag Ket 1971 within six monal of recept of this notice. The Secretary of State has power to allow a conger period for the giving of a notice of appeal, but he will not normally be prepared to exercise this person wheas there are openial circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of appeal. The Secretary of State is not required to entertain an appeal if it appears to him that permission r the proposed development could not have been so graphed otherwise than subject to the conditions imposed by the local planning authority having regard to the statutery requirements, to the provisions of the development order and to any direct, one given under the order. (The statutory requirements include Sections 70 and 77 of he Act.)
- 2. If permission to develop land is granted subject to conditions, whether by the local planning authority of by the Secretary of State, and the owner of the land claims that the land has become incapable of reasonable beneficiar use in its existing state and cannot be rendered capable of reasonably beneficial use by the carrying out of any development which has been or would be permitted, he may serve on the Council a purchase notice requiring the Council to our mase his interests in the land in accordance with the provision of Part IX of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
- 3. In certain circumstances, a claim may be made usuanst the local planning authority for compensation, where permission is stable in subject to consistions on the Secretary of State on appeal or on a reference of the application to him. The circuit stances in which such compensation is payable are set out in Section 160

General Information
