PLANNING (LISTED BUILDINGS AND CONSERVATION AREAS) ACT 1990
PLANNING (LISTED BUILDINGS AND CONSERVATION AREAS) REGULATIONS 1990
BUILDING 3, CARRIAGE ROW, EVERSOLT ST, NW1 (LB OF CAMDEN)

1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to say that consideration has been given to the Council's application, submitted with your letter of 20 May 1996, for listed building consent for the installation of low height glazed internal partitions to first and second floors at Building 3, Carriage Row, Eversholt Street, NW1 (shown on the statutory list of buildings of special architectural or historic interest in the London Borough of Camden as Nos 163 to 203 (odd) (Eversholt House) (West Side) Eversholt Street NW1). The application was made in accordance with the provisions of regulation 13 of the above Regulations.
2. It is noted that no objections/representations were received following public advertisement of the proposals. English Heritage raise no objection to the proposals.
3. It is considered that the works for which listed building consent is sought are acceptable as far as the special architectural and historical interests of the building are concerned. Accordingly, no reason is seen to withhold the consent sought and the Secretary of State hereby grants listed building consent for the installation of low height glazed internal partitions to first and second floors at Building 3, Carriage Row, Eversholt Street, NW1 in accordance with the Council's application dated 28 February 1996 and the submitted drawings, subject to the condition that the works to which this consent relates shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this consent.
4. This letter does not convey any approval or consent required by any enactment, byelaw, order or regulation other than Sections 8 and 16(1) of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.
