Reasons for refusal: The Council has prepared an amendment to the Development Plan for submission to the Minister of Housing and Local Government proposing a change in the zoning from residential to primary school, programmed for the Second Period of the Plan (1960-1972), and the erection of lock-up garages would not accord with this revised zoning and would prejudice the implementation of the school proposal.
