Permission for Development. (Conditional)

Development: Formation of a new building of part one, part two storeys at the rear of No. 39 Earlham Street, to function as an extension thereof, and for use as a lighting showroom.

 - 2 The development herein permitted must be begun not later than the expiration of five years from the date of permission.

 - 2 Imposed in accordance with the provisions of Section 41(1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
