London Government Act, 1963 - Section 43London Building Acts (Amendment) Act, 1939 - Part II

The G.L.C. have ordered that for the purpose of distinguishing it, the flat over 107 Camden High Street, entered from Delancey Passage shall be known as 4a Delancey Passage.

The building known as Greenhill Flats, Perrins Court, NW3 shall be known as Village Mount, Perrins Court.

The building in Conway Mews, W1, shall be known and described as follows:-

Entrance to offices - County House, 1 Conway Mews

Entrance to flats - 2 Conway Mews.

The dwelling formed on First Floor at 182 Drury Lane entered between 182 and 183 Drury Lane, WC2, shall be known as 182a Drury Lane.

The additional entrances at 44 Bedford Row, CW1 shall be known and described as follows:-

Main Ground Floor Entrance - 44a Bedford Row.

Separate Basement Entrance - 44b Bedford Row.

Separate Entrance to First & Upper Floors - 44 Bedford Row.

Secondary Ground Floor Entrance, from Sandland Street - 17 Sandland Street.

The entrance to the Maisonette on First & Second Floors at 42 Chalcot Road, shall be known as 42a Chalcot Road.

Nos. 88 & 89 High Holborn, WC1, shall be known as Burne House, 88/89 High Holborn.
