Town and Country Planning Act, 1962
Chester Terrace Redevelopment Area, St. Pancras

With reference to your letter dated 6 June 1963 concerning the above-mentioned premises, I am directed to inform you that pursuant to Condition (1) attached to the permission referred to in the Council's letter dated 29 November 1961 for the erection of a six-storey building including basement for use as ten shops and seven lock-up garages on the ground floor and 50 two-roomed flats on the first to fourth floors over and a garage for 75 cars at basement level forming Area Two, Chester Terrace, Chester Mews and Albany Street, St. Pancras, the Council has approved the details as shown on plans registered No. 5504 (your drawings Nos. 9/P.11CY, 27E2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 11), except as regards details of facing materials to tank rooms and fascias and pilasters which must form the subject of a further submission to the Council.
