- (i) No development shall be carried out on the land coloured pink on the applicants' said drawing until such land (other than the central island site bounded by New Oxford Street the castern arm of the new road improvement the southern arm of the new road improvement and Charing Cross Road as shown on the applicants' said drawing) has been cleared of all existing buildings
- (ii) No development on the said central island site shall be carried out until the development on the site bounded by New Oxford Street Earnshaw Street St. Giles High Street and the eastern arm of the new road improvement as shown on the applicant's said drawing, has been substantially completed to the satisfaction of the Council and all existing buildings on the said central island site have been cleared
