I refer to your letter dated 30th September 1971 submitting revised details for redevelopment of the Foundling Estate - Site 'A' pursuant to condition (1) of the outline permission dated 7th February 1963.

I have to inform you that the Council hereby disapproves revised detailed plans in respect of the following items as shown on the plans submitted Registered No 12055(E) Your Nos 19201, 19202, 19203, 9010 & 21225.

- (a) Omission of slab link (Grid lines 32-34) between pedestrian terraces at level 'C'.
- (b) Repositioning of public lawstories at north end of scheme (Grid lines 1-2).

Reasons

- (1) It is considered that a reduction in the number of links at level 'C' would seriously reduce the amonity of both the pedestrian terrace and the shorping hall.
- (2) The Council wishes to see the public levatories retained in that part of the scheme which is already comstructed, in order to provide a public amenity.

Informatives
