

Dear Sirs,

Town and Country Planning Act, 1962.
Amethill Square Development.

I am to inform you that for the purposes of the deemed permission granted by the Minister by virtue of the Town and Country Planning General (Amendment) Regulations 1965, the Council's Planning and Development Committee, at its meeting on the 6th December 1965, and in pursuance of condition 1 of the Planning Permission issued by the London County Council by letter dated 22nd January 1962, approved the details of Blocks 5-10 of the proposed redevelopment of the area bounded by Hampstead Road, Littleington Place, rear of railway premises in Overholt Street, Barnby Street and the railway cutting, Camden, comprising six six-storey blocks of maisonettes and a 1, 2 and 7 storey block of flats, shops, public house and welfare clinic.

I am to inform you that :

- a) this decision does not constitute approval of the details of the car parking provision, pedestrian and vehicular circulation, and landscaping associated with Blocks 5-10, which should form part of a further submission showing such details for the entire development which the Committee wishes to consider at the earliest opportunity.
- b) This decision is without prejudice to the Council's position as client for the development.
