For the purposes of the deemed permission granted by the Minister for Local Government and Development by virtue of Regulation 11 of the Town and Country Planning General Regulations, 1969, the Council approves the undermentioned development shown on the drawings submitted, Registered No. 13176 (Your Nos. 052/01-07 and forwarded under cover of your memorandum dated 14th March 1972 subject to the conditions referred to:

Development:

Erection of 12 five-bedroom maisonettes and 6 three-bedroom flats.

Conditions:

- 1. The siting, design, external appearance of the buildings and the means of access thereto shall be as approved before any work on the site is commenced.
- 2. Detailed plans and drawings with respect to the matters reserved for subsequent approval shall be submitted within three years from the date of this permission.
