LOCAL HOUSING OPERATIONS  
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947

Aircraft Road (No. 2) Site, St. Pancras.

1. The Council, in pursuance of its powers under the above-mentioned Act and the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, hereby permits the development referred to schedule below in accordance with the plans submitted.

This permission shall not be regarded as dispensing with the necessity for due compliance with any local Acts, regulations, building by-laws and general statutory provisions in force in the area, particularly the London Building Acts, 1930-39, and the by-laws in force thereunder, and nothing herein shall be deemed to be a consent by the Council thereunder.

The permission does not modify or affect any personal or restrictive covenants applying to the land or the rights of any person entitled to the benefits thereof.

SCHEDULE

Date of application: 6th February, 1951 (Ref. LGB/VJU).

Development: The use for housing purposes of The Aircraft Road (No. 2) Site, St. Pancras, as shown coloured pink on the plan submitted (Reg. No. 90/51 - Applicant's No. D. 5166).

Lay-out plan and detailed plans, sections and elevations of the proposed development should be submitted to the Council for approval.

2. As the proposed development involves the site of the "Prince of Wales" P.H. (Charrington) it is desirable that the Council should discuss their plans for the future of this house with the Licensing Planning Committee.

3. If anything of archaeological value is found during work on the site, the Ministry of Works (Inspectorate of Ancient Monuments and Historic Buildings) should be notified.
