### Reason for Standard Condition:

1. In order to comply with the provisions of Section 41 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

### Additional Condition(s):

- 01 The limited period for the retention of the storage container and the continuation of the use shall be until 1st May 1985 by which date the storage container shall be removed and the use discontinued and determined.

### Reason(s) for Additional Condition(s):

- 01 The type of structure is not such as the Council is prepared to approve, other than for a limited period, in view of its appearance.
