TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947

Refusal of permission to develop

The Council in pursuance of its powers under the above mentioned Act and The Town and Country Planning (General Development) Order 1948, hereby refuses to permit the development referred to in the undermentioned schedule as shown on the plans submitted.

Date of application - 2nd November, 1948.

Plans submitted No. 9550.

Development *as a builder's yard* - The erection of a builder's store and the use of the site of railway land between Nos. 44 and 49, Camden Square, St. Pancras.

Reasons for refusal. The proposal would not accord with the Council's redevelopment proposals for this area and would be likely adversely to affect the amenities of the surrounding residential neighbourhood.
