TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971. TOWN AND COUNTRY AMENITIES ACT 1974. TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (LISTED BUILDINGS AND BUILDINGS IN CONSERVATION AREAS) REGULATIONS 1972 AND (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1974. NO 36 CAMDEN ROAD, NWY

1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to say that he has considered your Council's application submitted with your letter of 14 August 1975 for listed building consent to alter the above-mentioned building. The application was made in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 10 of the Town and Country Planning (Listed Buildings and Buildings in Conservation Areas) Regulations 1972 as now amended by the 1974 Regulations referred to above.

2. It is noted that no representations were received following advertisement of the proposals and that your Council are prepared to meet the Greater London Council's recommendations on the proposed alterations. No reason is seen, therefore, to withhold the consent sought, and, accordingly, the Secretary of State hereby grants listed building consent for the alterations involved in converting No 36 Camden Road, NW1, into 2 maisonettes, as shown on the enclosed drawings Nos 49/1B, 2B, 3A, 4A (Registered No HB/1092).

3. This letter does not convey any approval or consent required by any enactment, byelaw, order or regulation other than Sections 55 and 56 of the Foun and Country Planning Act 1971.
