I refer to the proposal by the London Borough of Camden to convert the above premises into flats and maisonettes.

This Council raises no objection to the proposals indicated on Plans Regd. No. CO1747 (Applicants Nos. A/1014/B, 1015/A, and 1016/B) subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) All new work and work of making good shall match the existing original work as closely as possible in terms of materials and in detailed execution;
- (ii) the proposed dustbin enclosure shall be formed out of the existing railings;
- (111) the arch to the door on the rear extension shall be formed as an axed segmental brick arch to match the existing window openings as closely as possible;
- (1v) the new rear window at third floor level shall be formed as a wooden framed, louble hung sliding sash window subdivided by glazing tars.
