TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (LISTED BUILDINGS AND BUILDINGS IN
CONSERVATION AREAS) REGULATIONS 1972 (AS AMENDED) 1974, 50 CAMDEN RD NW1

1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to say that he has considered your Council's application submitted with your letter of 16 July 1975 for listed building consent for the alteration of No 50 Camden Road, NW1, which is on the statutory list of buildings of special architectural or historic interest. The application was made in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 10 of the Town and Country Planning (Listed Buildings and Buildings in Conservation Areas) Regulations 1972 as now amended by the 1974 Regulations referred to above.

2. It is noted that the only representation received was not concerned with the listed building aspect of your Council's proposals and that the Greater London Council raise no objection to this scheme, subject to certain detailed conditions which are acceptable to your Council. No reason is seen, therefore, to withhold the consent sought, and, accordingly, the Secretary of State hereby grants listed building consent for the alterations involved in the conversion of No 50, Camden Rd, NW1 to provide two self-contained flats, one self-contained bed-sitting room and one self-contained maisonette which includes the re-building of the rear extension as shown on drawings Nos 81/A/1014/B, 81/A/1015/A and 81/A/1015/B.

3. This letter does not convey any approval or consent required by any enactment, byelaw, order or regulation other than Sections 55 and 56 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971.

4. A copy of this letter is being sent to the Greater London Council.
