1. I am directed by the Minister of Housing and Local Government to refer to your Company's appeal made under Section 16 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, against the refusal of the London County Council to permit the use of the above premises as an office.

2. The Minister has had before him the representations set out in the form of appeal and the statement of the Council's case attached to their letter of the 25th August, 1961. One of his officers has visited the premises.

The Minister is satisfied, that the appeal premises which were purpose built for residential use a few years ago are quite capable of continued residential use and he cannot accept that there are any very special circumstances in this case to justify even the temporary loss of this housing accommodation.
