Your particular attention is drawn to the provisions of the London Building Acts, 1930-39, and the Byelaws in force thereunder which must be complied with to the satisfaction of the District Surveyor, 108a, Finchley Road, Hampstead, N.W.3. (Telephone No. HAMPstead 4867.)

I would also remind you that the Council's permission does not modify or affect any personal or restrictive covenants, easements, etc., applying to or affecting the land or the rights of any persons entitled to the benefits thereof.

Conditions:

(1) The limited period for the use hereby permitted shall be one year from the first day of August 1961 at the expiration of which period the use herein allowed shall be discontinued without compensation unless the Council shall have previously approved continuance of the use for a further period.

(2) In the event of a betting office licence in respect of these premises not being obtained, or, having been obtained, being withdrawn at a later date, then the user herein approved shall be discontinued and determined at the same time.
