 - (3) This permission being personal to Mrs. Stella Mann, and not enuring for the benefit of the land.
 - (4) The building not being used as a dance hall or for the holding of public dances.

(1) of the necessity of submitting an application with plans in duplicate under Section 34 of the London Building Acts (Amendment) Act, 1939, as regards means of escape in case of fire and in this connection, the Council's officers should be consulted as to the suitability of the sliding folding doors at the eastern end of the building; and

(2) of the necessity of complying with By-law 3.12 of the London Building Acts for crushing strength of the light weight concrete blocks.
