London Government Act, 1963 - Section 43  
London Building Act (Amendment) Act 1939 Part 2.

The G.L.C. have ordered that for the purpose of distinguishing it, the building known as Coach House, at the rear of 12 Rossllyn Hill, NW3 should be known and described as the Coach House, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  Hampstead Hill Gardens.

The sixth shop on ground floor at Hinstock, 210 Belsize Road. NW6 should be known and described as 212, to 222 (e) Belsize Road (South East to North West).

The building on site of the former 120 to 126 Albert Street, NW1 shall be known and described as follows:-

Entrance to Kings Fund Centre - 126 Albert Street.  
Entrance to adjoining flats - 124 Albert Street.

The rear entrance to centre (from Arlington Road) 147 Arlington Road.  
The new block of flats on site of the former 149 to 155 Arlington Rd, - 155 Arlington Road.

The new house adjoining 49 Downshire Hill, NW3 should be known and described as 49a, Downshire Hill.
